DAY 01

Delhi – Agra

(210 km, 4-5 hrs)

Agra Just over 210 kms. from Delhi, is Agra, the city of Taj Mahal a poem in white marble built in the 16th century by the emperor Shahjahan as a monument of love. Agra was once the capital of the Mughals and the relics of the glory are scattered all over the city. From the Taj Mahal to the massive Agra Fort, the delicately carved Itmad-ud-Daulah's tomb, Akbar's deserted majestic capital Fatehpur Sikri, Agra is India's best-known tourist destination




Today early morning, you will be driven to Agra. Arrive Agra and check-in at hotel.

You will proceed to the old and abandoned capital city of Emperor Akbar at Fatehpur Sikri. Return to hotel by evening Overnight at the hotel.

DAY 02

Agra – Delhi

After breakfast, in the morning You will then visit the Taj Mahal. The Taj Mahal is everything that has been said about it and more ... Taking 22 years and 20,000 men to build, the white marble was quarried 200 miles away and was transported to the site by a fleet of 1000 elephants. Built by the Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan as an expression of his love for his wife Mumtaz Mahal, in mid 17th century, the Taj Mahal is truly one of the wonders of the world. Though the Taj appears to be amazingly perfect from almost any angle, it is the close-up marble inlay work, which is really astounding. You will have ample time to view and be mesmerised by this outstanding piece of architecture in the light of setting sun and to later assemble with the whole group for a photograph with the Taj as a backdrop.



(210 km, 4-5 hrs)

Check-out from the hotel and proceed for sightseeing of Agra Fort built by the great Emperor Akbar in 1565 A.D., the fort is a masterpiece of design and construction. Within the fort are a number of exquisite buildings, including the Moti Masjid, Diwane-

i-Am, Diwane-i-Khas and Musamman Burj, where the Emperor Shah Jahan died in imprisonment, besides Jahangir's Palace, Khaas Mahal and the Sheesh Mahal.

Late afternoon, you will be driven back to Delhi. Arrive Delhi and transfer to railway station or airport for further destination or drop at hotel
